- D. Fisherman will spread nets on the site to dry (v-5)
- E. The debris will be thrown into the water (v-12)
- F. She will never be rebuilt (v-14)
- G. She will never be found again (v-21)

#### SIDON

EZEKIEL 28:22,23

- A. There is no mention of her destruction or extinction
- B. Blood will be in the streets (v-23)
- C. A sword will be on every side (v-23)
