STUDY OF EZEKIEL

Brother Leon King has been preaching through the book of Ezekiel for many months - chapter by chapter, verse by verse. It has been a marvelous and inspiring study to say the least. Chapters 36 through 40 detail God's giving Israel a new heart, his putting His spirit in them, and his laws in them.

It goes on to show the nation experiences:

- A gathering from all the nations to which they are now scattered back to the land promised to Abraham, Isaac, and Jacob the land of Israel.
- The destruction of Israels most bitter enemies those who hated them with perpetual hatred, which are represented in Scripture as Mount Seir - obviously the descendants of Esau and Amalek, the grandson of Esau.
- In that land, they shall dwell safely and shall be established as one nation. No longer will they be divided as they have been since the days of Rehoboam, King of Judah.
- In chapters 38 and 39, we are told that God will put hooks in the jaws of Gog, the chief prince of Meshech and Tubal bringing him and a host of nations against the mountains of Israel. It is interesting to note that the nations mentioned in these chapters are either Islamic or greatly influenced by Islam. The tenor of these chapters is that God has determined to destroy Gog and his allies on the mountains of Israel so that the heathen will know that God has delivered Israel and that Israel has gone into a dispersed captivity because of their sins.
- Chapters 40-48 describes a new temple (which I have called "The Millennial Temple." We saw that God, himself, returned to the eastern gate of this temple and called it the "place of the soles of his feet," and that he would dwell among his people Israel for ever. In these chapters, we are

told about the method of sacrifices and worship in this temple. We are also told that the "Prince" of Israel shall sit in the inner eastern gate to eat bread before the Lord. In these chapters, we see a river of living water come out from under the threshold of the temple and go out to the east and down into the desert country where it heals the waters of the sea (which is obviously the Dead Sea.) We are also told that the land is re-divided to all the tribes of Israel with a portion for the Lord which will have in it the temple, a place for the priests, the Levites, and the city.
