

# Evolution – Wicked Mens’ Religion

**Genesis 1:1 *In the beginning God created the heaven and the earth.***

**Romans 1:19-23 *Because that which may be known of God is manifest in them; for God hath shewed it unto them. For the invisible things of him from the creation of the world are clearly seen, being understood by the things that are made, even his eternal power and Godhead; so that they are without excuse: Because that, when they knew God, they glorified him not as God, neither were thankful; but became vain in their imaginations, and their foolish heart was darkened. Professing themselves to be wise, they became fools, And changed the glory of the uncorruptible God into an image made like to corruptible man, and to birds, and fourfooted beasts, and creeping things.***

The theory of evolution is another of wicked man’s religious inventions. It is a religion without God. It is a religion that denies God. It is the religion of fools, for the Scriptures declare, *“The fool hath said in his heart, there is no God.”* In fact, the Scriptures record that exact expression a couple of times. Hear me, dear reader, these are not my words, they are God’s words.

Men love their wickedness – their fornication, adultery, lasciviousness, uncleanness, perversion, and such – therefore they do not like to retain God in their knowledge. So, professing themselves to be wise, they become fools in denying God as the creator and sustainer of the universe. Wicked, unbelieving men do not like to think of God as the source of their life. Like the Greeks of old, they deny the very God in whom they live, and move, and have their being.

The evolutionists are in some sense different than those who deify stocks and stones. They do not fall down and worship the works of their own hands that cannot hear, see, taste, touch, or feel. No sir! They do not fall down before stocks! They fall down before wicked man! For them, man is the author and finisher of his own fate. They say that men are getting better and better, the continued multiplicity of murders, mugging, thievery, rapes, plunders, war, and such like notwithstanding.

Dear Reader, perhaps you are "on the fence" with this issue. Or maybe, you have not yet come to a conclusion. In this land we still have the freedom to believe and act according to the dictates of our own conscience. Like you, fellow American, I am deeply grateful for that privilege. Please consider two or three things with me about those who are the advocates of evolution.

### **Evolution and Creation are not compatible.**

Not only are evolution and creation incompatible, they are mutually exclusive. In other words, if one be true, then the other cannot be true. Evolution says that men and the universe around them just happened. According to those who believe this whopping lie, everything came to be by chance over millions and millions of years. Sometime, somewhere in the distant past, life came by chance. Single cell creatures just happened, then these creatures, by chance, developed more cells – then fins, eyes, ears, arms, and legs. They moved from the water to the land and continued to develop into "higher creatures." All of this by chance – mind you! Everything was in the right place, at the right time, and the circumstance made it all come to pass. For them, there was no author or designer – it just happened. Dear friend, if you believe that, then please do not say you believe the Bible. Will you admit the truth? If you are an evolutionist, then you cannot be a Bible-believing Christian.

Bible-believing Christians believe the Genesis account of creation. The eternal God created the heaven and the earth in the beginning according to the very first verse of the Bible. If you believe that verse, then you cannot believe evolution. You may think you do, but you need to evaluate your position. These are the words of Jesus Christ:

**John 5:46-47** *For had ye believed Moses, ye would have believed me: for he wrote of me. But if ye believe not his writings, how shall ye believe my words?*

Moses is accepted as the author of the first five books of the Bible. He wrote Genesis which says, "*In the beginning God created the heaven and the earth.*" Do you believe that? If you do, then you cannot believe everything came to be by chance. God created the heaven and the earth. The first chapter of Genesis tells specifically that God created all that is in our universe including man. Genesis says he did this in six days. Are these literal days? If there is a literal God, then the days are literal. The scriptures say, "*And the morning and the evening were the first day.*" ". . . *second day.*" ". . . *third day,*" etc.

### **Some claim to believe in Theistic Evolution.**

Since about 1860 A.D., a new theory was developed by some professing Christian theologians. The theory is sometimes referred to as the "Genesis Gap Theory." According to reputable sources, Charles Darwin's book, *The Origin of Species*, was published on November 24th, 1859. Up to that time, no theologian (that the author of this article has found) advocated a "gap" of time between Genesis 1:1 and 1:2. According to them, there is a great period of time between the time God created the heaven and the earth and the time when God began to form the earth into the manner in which it presently exists.

These Theistic Evolutionists say that God used time and chance to bring things into their present state.

There is no "soft" way to say this, so I will just say it. I believe these men came up with this theory to accommodate the "oppositions of science, falsely so-called." Most of those who profess faith in Christ and believe the Bible never fell for this Theistic Evolution. They believe God created everything, including man, in six literal days just as Genesis records.

As far as this author is concerned, Theistic Evolution is a flat denial of the Genesis account of creation. Since there is no scriptural evidence for such belief, then it follows that those who advocate the same are actually unbelievers. Nobody can believe Christ who does not believe Moses.

### **President Bush's Move for Intelligent Design.**

Our President has advocated that the government schools teach "Intelligent Design" along with the evolutionary theory for creation. Let us be careful not to place the whole blame on him for this move – for he has been the hearer of lots of advice from his educational prognosticators. This is a political move to appease both sides - creationists and evolutionists - and bring them to compromise. That God created the heaven and the earth is sufficient to understand that there was intelligent design behind creation. The term "Intelligent Design" was coined as a euphemism so that men do not have to admit that God created all. For this author, this term is totally unacceptable. While God is certainly intelligent and certainly designed the heaven and the earth, it is blasphemy to term creation as "Intelligent Design" in order to leave the name of God out of it.

The Lord's churches have responsibility as the "pillar and ground of the truth," therefore, should not be advocates of the "Intelligent Design" movement. Let's say it like it is! Why muzzle and confound

#### **Most believe Genesis, want evolution taught**

Most Americans believe God created humans on the sixth day of the universe, yet they also overwhelmingly want science-based evolution taught in public school, according to a Scripps Howard/Ohio University poll.

Half of the 1,005 adults interviewed support President Bush's suggest that public schools should also teach intelligent design, the notion that God played a role in the evolution of humans. But only 17 percent said they believe in intelligent design when asked their opinion of humanity's origins.

Fifty-four percent said they believe 'God created the universe and humans in a six-day period;' 23 percent said 'humans evolved from other animal species through natural selection,' and 17 percent said 'God caused humans to evolve from other species.' Six percent were undecided."

Like many of you, the author is always a bit skeptical about polls conducted by colleges and such. In any case, according to this article, nobody really believes in the Genesis account of creation as it is written. Such testimony makes one shudder at the utter disdain for the word of the living God. According to this alleged poll, most of the professing Christians they spoke with want the Intelligent Design taught along with Science-based Evolution. Now there's a suggestive term if there ever was one! "Science-based Evolution." Isn't science something that is observed? Do you really think humans observed and recorded evolution from the eons of the past as many believe? Not a

chance. It is a kind of "faith" developed by wicked men to leave God out of their thinking.

### **The Evolutionists Assertions.**

Probably without exception, all human beings ask themselves several questions about their origin. This starts early in life when children ask their parents, "Where do babies come from?"
